A BILL to acquire resources for the LGBTQ+ Center.

1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;

2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, "To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.";

3) WHEREAS, the on-campus LGBTQ+ community and Devaria Ponton, the Director of Multicultural Affairs, have expressed interest in having more resources for the new space and upcoming resource center.

4) WHEREAS, the center is now located on the second floor of the Student Center, within the office of Multicultural Affairs.

5) WHEREAS, the purchase of these resources would provide satisfaction to the students as well as a safe environment free from any discrimination, biases, and criticism.

6) WHEREAS, the space is where PRISM and TAG (Transgender Advocacy Group) have their weekly meetings for members and the executive team.

7) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that six hundred dollars be allocated from the SGA Senate Fall Quarter project fund to purchase bean bags, a mirror, and desks for the completion of this project. All unused funds for this project will be returned to the SGA.
