A BILL to acquire iPads for the Counseling Center.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;

- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;

- 3) WHEREAS, Counseling Services has a seventy-five percent recurrence rate amongst students from the 2019-2021 academic school year in just this Fall 2022 quarter alone.

4) WHEREAS, Currently Counseling Services has four iPads purchased by SGA to benefit student care.

5) WHEREAS, Those four iPads have allowed for quick, efficient consultations.

6) WHEREAS, There are currently fifteen practitioners utilizing the four iPads and are having to rotate them throughout the day, delaying consults.

7) WHEREAS, To effectively serve the student body, the Counseling Center needs more iPads to not only have more consults during the day, but to be more available for any crisis during their twenty-four seven on call periods.

8) WHEREAS, In order to better serve students, more iPads are needed to streamline check-in and session notes.

9) WHEREAS, Counseling Services has expressed the need for the on-call staff member to be able to take home an iPad to serve students in crisis situations.


10) WHEREAS, The proposal for this purchase was made through the Apple Store for Education Institution.

11) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that One thousand seven hundred ninety-one dollars and eighty cents be allocated from the SGA Senate Fall Quarter project fund for the purchase of four iPads with AppleCare and four protective cases. All unused funds for this project will be returned to the SGA.


