A RESOLUTION to convey student support for a change of Summer Commencement ceremonies from the Thursdays to the Saturdays.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;
- 3) WHEREAS, the current summer commencements falls on the first Thursday after the last day of classes;

4) WHEREAS, Ryan Richard, Coordinator of Planning and Advancement, and several students support the change of summer commencement to Saturdays;

5) WHEREAS, the change of day will be more convenient for graduates who work full time during the summer and cannot attend commencement ceremonies on Thursdays;

6) WHEREAS, the change will allow for more graduates' families and loved ones to attend the summer commencement ceremonies;

7) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that the Student Body of Louisiana Tech University petitions the Administrative Planning Committee to consider and change summer commencement ceremonies from the current Thursdays to Saturdays.

8) Be It Further Resolved That, suitable copies of this resolution be transmitted to University President Dr. Les Guice, University Vice Presidents, and any other university personnel deemed appropriate.




