A RESOLUTION to give the Executive Council of the Louisiana Tech University Interfraternity Council (IFC) a much-needed office to conduct business.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;
- 3) WHEREAS, the IFC does not have office space to meet, store their files, and conduct business;

4) WHEREAS, the IFC Vice President has taken on more duties and needs to print and file documents on a day-to-day basis;

5) WHEREAS, with such office space, any fraternity member would have the opportunity to come to the IFC office during office hours for reasons pertaining to their fraternity or IFC in general;

6) WHEREAS, IFC needs a place to conduct business in a professional office, as it governs ten University-recognized fraternities.

7) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that the Student Body supports IFC having an office on campus and recognizes this is an urgent matter to be taken care of as soon as possible;

7) Be It Further Resolved That, suitable copies of this resolution be transmitted to Dr. Les Guice, University President, Dr. Dickie Crawford, Associate Vice President for Student Advancement, Dr. Sam Speed, Dean of Student Engagement and Undergraduate Recruitment, and any other university personnel deemed appropriate.
