A RESOLUTION to urge both the Louisiana Tech University Campus Police Department and the Parking and Traffic Committee to change the current traffic situation involving the A.E. Phillips pickup and drop off line.

1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;

2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;

3) WHEREAS, parents of students that attend the on-campus laboratory school, A.E. Phillips, line up as they await to pick up their children in a heavy traffic zone.

4) WHEREAS, students on campus are forced to wait for the line of cars to disperse before being able to move their cars.

5) WHEREAS, students are unable to park in a lot that they pay to park in, due to the line of cars blocking the lot.

6) WHEREAS, the parents, who are in the line of cars, park in student parking spaces that they do not pay for, preventing students from being able to utilize the lot.

7) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that the Student Body petitions the Louisiana Tech University Campus Police and the Traffic and Parking Committee to change the positioning of the A.E. Phillip pickup line, and remove it from the high traffic zone it is currently located.

7) Be It Further Resolved That, suitable copies of this resolution be transmitted to Louisiana Tech Police, the Traffic and Parking Committee, Dr. Les Guice, University President, University Vice Presidents, Dr. Jenny Blalock, Director of A.E. Phillips Laboratory School, and any other university personnel deemed appropriate.
