A BILL to purchase classroom supplies for George T. Madison Hall.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;
- 3) WHEREAS, professors in George T. Madison Hall have a lack of supplies in their classrooms;

4) WHEREAS, various professors in the College of Liberal Arts have to purchase and bring their own writing utensils to class each day;

5) WHEREAS, the purchase of dry erase markers and chalk to keep in every classroom would aid professors in their instruction abilities;

6) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that five hundred dollars be allocated from the Spring Senate Project Fund to the purchase of markers and chalk for George T. Madison Hall. All unused funds for this project shall be returned to the SGA.
