A BILL to purchase a Little Free Library.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;
- 3) WHEREAS, campus wide literacy among students is a priority;
- 4) WHEREAS, students have expressed a need and want for convenient unrestricted

5) WHEREAS, the purchase of a Little Free Library would satisfy the student need; improving the student experience by providing a method for students to acquire college-aged targeted books at any time;

6) WHEREAS, the purchase of the Little Free Library is to be in accordance with the aesthetics committee's wishes, Composite Two Story Arched Little Free Library, Composite Screw In Library Post and Topper Black ; the cost is five hundred sixty-nine dollars and ninety cents in addition to shipping and handling; an additional three hundred thirty dollars and 10 cents will allocated for shipping along with installation;

7) WHEREAS, the location of the Little Free Library is as specified; the northwest corner of Tolliver Hall near Wisteria Drive;

8) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that nine hundred dollars be allocated from the Winter Senate Project Fund to the purchase and installation of a Little Free Library to be installed on the northwest corner of Tolliver Hall. All unused funds for this project shall be returned to the SGA.

Being proposed on the 10th of January 2023, the Secretary reports: **PASSAGE**


