A RESOLUTION to request the addition of a crosswalk at the intersection of W Railroad Ave and Mayfield Ave.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;
- 3) WHEREAS, student foot traffic at the intersection of W Railroad and Mayfield has increased due to parking availability and newly constructed campus residential halls;

4) WHEREAS, several students have approached the Student Government Association about pedestrian safety on campus;


5) WHEREAS, students currently lack a safe manner of crossing at this intersection;

7) Be It Further Resolved That, suitable copies of this resolution be transmitted to Dr. Les Guice, University Vice Presidents, Chief Randal Hermes, and any other university personnel deemed appropriate.
