A RESOLUTION to convey student senate support for a joint session between the student senate and the university faculty and staff senate.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
  
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;
  
- 3) WHEREAS, the Student Senate discusses issues pertaining to students and the University Senate discusses issues pertaining to the faculty and staff.

4) WHEREAS, Student Government and the University Senate have had minimal to no communication with each other ever since they were both formed.

5) WHEREAS, many issues have come up that pertain to both parties which would make it beneficial to not only have open communication, but also to have a joint session between the two senates.

) WHEREAS, a joint session with the University Senate would benefit both parties and especially students by making student issues known to faculty.

6) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that we have a joint session between the student senate and faculty and staff senate.

7) Be It Further Resolved That, suitable copies of this resolution be transmitted to Dr. Les Guice, University Vice Presidents, the university senate president Dr. Louis Reis, and any other university personnel deemed appropriate.

Being proposed on the 31st of January 2023, the Secretary reports: **PASSAGE**


