A BILL to purchase a new gel electrophoresis power pack and four chambers for Carson Taylor Hall .

1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;

2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana

Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;

3) WHEREAS, students and faculty in Carson Taylor Hall have minimal gel electrophoresis machines for studying purposes;

4) WHEREAS, Dr. Jeff Shultz, of the Department of Applied and Natural Sciences, has expressed general student concern regarding a lack of gel electrophoresis machines accessible to students and faculty;

5) WHEREAS, the purchase of a new gel electrophoresis power pack and four chambers would satisfy the student need in Carson Taylor Hall by opening four additional seats in BISC 291 per section and allow more access to research for students, graduate students, and faculty ;

6) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that one-thousand seven hundred forty-five dollars and ninety-nine cents be allocated from the Winter Senate Project Fund to the purchase of a new gel electrophoresis power pack and four chambers for Carson Taylor Hall. All unused funds for this project shall be returned to the SGA.
