A Bill to convey Senate support for fixing the starting blocks on the pool deck  
at the Lambright Sports and Wellness Center

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;
- 3) WHEREAS, the starting blocks at the Lambright Sports and Wellness Center are not in good condition and action must be taken in a

timely manner.

4) WHEREAS, several Tech Students and High School Students have approached the Student Government Association regarding the bad condition of the starting blocks at Lambright;

5) WHEREAS, The Lambright pool is home to the Louisiana Tech swim club, Ruston High, Cedar Creek, Choadrourant, Simsboro, and West Monroe Swimming, as well as the largest swim club in North Louisiana, Bulldog Aquatics;

6) WHEREAS, Lambright hosts dozens of swim meets year round which can have as many as 200- 300 swimmers. Which can be a huge recruiting opportunity for our campus.

7) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that the Student Body petitions the University Administration to pursue efforts to resurface the starting blocks at Lambright in a swift and timely manner.

8) Be It Further Resolved That, suitable copies of this resolution be transmitted to Dr. Jim Henderson, University Vice Presidents, Payton Carnahan the Assistant Director for Recreation and any other university personnel deemed appropriate.
