A BILL to purchase new tables for student organization use.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;

- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;

- 3) WHEREAS, student organizations currently have limited access to tables for campus activities;

4) WHEREAS, the Student Government Association and Career Services have expressed interest in purchasing tables for student activities use;

5) WHEREAS, the purchase of new tables would satisfy the need for student organizations to have access to tables;

6) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that 2,750 dollars be allocated from the Fall Senate Project Fund to the purchase of 10 new tables to be stored in the Downstairs TONK. All unused funds for this project shall be returned to the SGA.
