A BILL to purchase a new golf cart for the LA Tech Police Department.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;

- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;

3) WHEREAS, the Police Department golf carts are used by student organizations when hosting events, by Admissions for tours, and the by Police Department for student escorts;

4) WHEREAS, there are two older, smaller golf carts not being utilized and are occupying space;

5) WHEREAS, the Student Government Association has expressed interest in purchasing a 6-seater lithium battery powered golf cart;

6) WHEREAS, the purchase of a new golf cart would satisfy the need for transportation around campus

7) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that \$7595 dollars be allocated from the Fall Senate Project Fund to the purchase of a new golf cart for the La Tech Police Department. All unused funds for this project shall be returned to the SGA.
