A RESOLUTION to recognize Emma Foltz, a student who truly embodied the bulldog spirit and what it means to be a Louisiana Tech bulldog by saving the lives of fourteen kids during the flash flood that occurred.

- 1) WHEREAS, the Louisiana Tech Student Government Association, hereafter referred to as the SGA, is the governing body of Louisiana Tech University;
  
- 2) WHEREAS, according to 1.03.A.C. of the Constitution of the SGA of Louisiana Tech University, which is included in the list of purposes of the SGA reads, “To establish and execute such programs and projects beneficial to the students.”;

3) WHEREAS, Emma Foltz, a student at Louisiana Tech demonstrated extraordinary bravery and quick thinking by saving campers during a flood at Camp Mystic.

5) WHEREAS, Emma Foltz actions prevented any injuries or fatalities and exemplified the values of leadership, bravery, and selflessness, putting the well-being of others above personal safety.

6) WHEREAS, Emma Foltz is a role model and exemplary student in our school community, demonstrating that true heroism is not measured by recognition, but by the willingness to act in the face of danger for the safety of others.

7) THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the SGA Senate that Emma Foltz is an exemplary student and embodies the true meaning and characters of the bulldog.
